Precision Teaching

- Precision Teaching emphasises accuracy and fluency and teaches the most useful skills first.
- It is a method of precisely finding out which teaching approaches work and then using them.
- It is systematic and tightly monitored.
- Evidence based research.
- All TA's and DR to receive advanced training.
- This will take place over 4 training sessions.
- Delivered by Will Roberts (School Ed Psychologist).
- This will support children with spelling, reading, handwriting and maths.

- Reviewing and evaluating current format and style of our IEPs.
- Aim is to make it more child friendly.

- This will be trialled in the spring term where we will welcome feedback from children and parents.
