

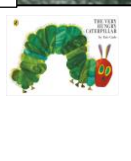
Reception- Summer Term



English

We will continue to practice writing using our 'fred fingers' to listen to the sounds in the words we are writing as well as using finger spaces and full stops. We will be developing our sentence writing, where we will be writing for a variety of different purposes.

We are reading...



- We will be reading 'The Three little Pigs' and 'The very hungry Caterpillar' by Eric Carle.

Maths

In maths the children will be learning:

- Numbers to 20 and beyond
- Addition and Subtraction
- 2d shapes and 3d shapes
- Sharing and grouping
- Patterns

RWI

We will be consolidating learning of all Set 1 & 2 sounds and using these to read and write simple sentences.

Expressive Arts and Design

Whilst learning the story of the 'Three Little Pigs', the children will produce props and materials to help them role the characters in the story.

Understanding the world

We will look at the life cycle of different creatures and see how they change and observe different habitats.

We will think about how we have changed in our lifetime.

We look at different religious festivals such as 'Eid Al-Fitr' and 'Eid Al-Adha'.

We will be thinking about our move into Year 1. We will talk about some of the feelings we may experience and ways we can feel good about the change.

We will also discuss how the children starting in September may be feeling and thinking of ways that we can help them feel good about starting school.
