In this term we will focus on the texts:

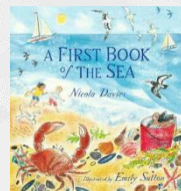
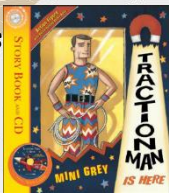
We are reading...

- Writing a narrative about the experiences of others.

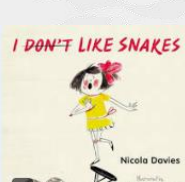
A book of the sea
