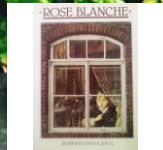
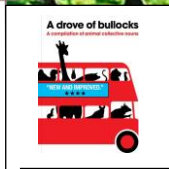

- They will be designing, making and evaluating Fairtrade cookies.

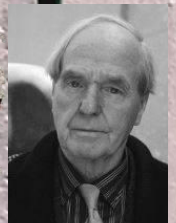
Science
