- QE2 (Ofsted) Continue to embed the school's strategy to reading and early reading through Read Write Inc. Ensure the Lowest 20% are Kept on Track with 1:1 tutoring, precision teaching and <u>Fresh Start</u>.
- QE3 (Ofsted) To ensure 100% of children make at least <u>Expected Progress</u> in English and Mathematics in all year groups, with a strong focus on <u>Writing (Years 4, 5, 6) and Mathematics (Years 2, 3, 4, 6).</u>
- QE4 To ensure that in end of key stage assessments, the school's results continue to be Above National Average.
- L1 Enhance the school's approach to <u>Retrieval</u> to embed deep learning across the curriculum ensuring children can do more, know more and can remember more.
- L3 <u>Appraisal</u> in place for 100% of all staff ensuring that staff or supported and challenged to reach their full potential and celebrating key successes using the new trust wide PDR Policy and applying the BASICs Coaching Model.
- L2 Continue to develop the role of the <u>TA</u> to create <u>Specialisms</u> of targeted support to meet the needs of all children alongside the school's Educational Psychologist.
