

## Oreston Community Academy School Improvement Key Priorities 2021-2022



- QE1 Follow the Recovery Plan to meet the needs of all children following Covid:19 school closures.
- QE5 (Ofsted) To ensure 100% of children make at least expected progress in English and Mathematics in all year groups, with a strong focus on Mathematics in Key Stage 1 and Challenging the Most Able Learners across all subject areas.
- QE6 To ensure that in end of key stage assessments, the school's results are Above the National Average.
- QE3 (Ofsted) Embed Read Write Inc. to ensure a consistent approach across the school ensuring that 100% of children make the expected sustained progress across each phase and the % of children passing the phonics screening exceeds the national average. Ensure the Lowest 20% are Kept on Track with 1:1 tutoring and pinny time.
- QE2 (Ofsted) Embed the Curriculum to ensure that the skills and knowledge acquisition is age appropriate, cumulative and meets the needs of all learners for all subject areas
- L1 Embed the reviewed approach to High Quality Teaching and Learning across all subjects using the planning proforma, building on CPD opportunities and working together as a whole school team.
- L3 Enhance the role of the Teaching Assistants to create specialisms of targeted support to meet the needs of all children alongside the school's Educational Psychologist.
