

Oreston Community Academy School Improvement Key Priorities 2020-2021



- QE1 Follow the recovery plan to meet the needs of all children following the school closure with particular support in place for children in Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 and those with SEND.
- QE5 (Ofsted) To ensure 100% of children make at least expected progress in English and Mathematics in all year groups, with a strong focus on Mathematics in Key Stage 1.
- QE6 To ensure that in end of key stage assessments, the school's results are above the national average.
- QE3 (Ofsted) Launch and embed Read Write Inc to implement a consistent approach across the school ensuring that 100% of children make the expected sustained progress across each phase and the % of children passing the phonics screening exceeds the national average.
- QE2 (Ofsted) Embed the curriculum to ensure that the skills and knowledge acquisition is age appropriate, cumulative and meets the needs of all learners for all subject areas
- QE4 Develop the homework provision across the school that consolidates learning and deepens the children's understanding of a variety of subjects building on the success of e-home learning.
- L1 Continue to develop Teaching and Learning to be consistently highly effective across the whole school, building on CPD opportunities and working together as a whole school team to embed the new planning proforma based on the key Rosenshine Principles.
